

## 939, 3779. ACKERMANN

1. **Lienhardt<sup>I/J</sup> Ackermann**,<sup>[1]</sup> known as “alt” Lienhardt, died at Erbstetten, duchy of Württemberg,<sup>[2]</sup> on 12 September 1635.<sup>[3]</sup> He first married **Martha** \_\_\_\_\_, who was the mother of his children. She was born about 1547, died at Erbstetten on 27 October 1617, and was buried the following day, aged 70 years.<sup>[4]</sup> Lienhardt then married secondly, at Erbstetten on 28 February 1619, **Waldburga** (\_\_\_\_) **Gleich**, widow of Georg Gleich of Weiler zum Stein.<sup>[5]</sup> She seems to be the widow of Lienhardt Ackermann, *ein Knecht*, who died at Erbstetten on 13 November 1635.<sup>[6]</sup> Lienhardt and his second wife had no known children, though she seems to be the mother of Michel, stepson of Leonhart Ackermann, who was buried at Erbstetten on 2 January 1629, aged 15 years.<sup>[7]</sup> The family’s major residence, Erbstetten, had belonged to Württemberg since 1453.<sup>[8]</sup>

2. **Lienhardt<sup>I</sup> Ackermann**<sup>[10]</sup> (*Lienhardt<sup>I/J</sup>*) known as “jung” Lienhardt, was baptized at Erbstetten on 25 October 1577. The sponsor at his baptism was Peter Kerns of Erbstetten.<sup>[11]</sup> Lienhardt was buried at Erbstetten on 18 October 1634.<sup>[12]</sup> He first married **Margaretha Kleinknecht** on 10 July 1598 at Erbstetten.<sup>[13]</sup> She was born, by calculation, and baptized at Erbstetten on 12 February 1570, the daughter of Lorentz and Margaretha (\_\_\_\_) Kleinknecht of Mittelschöntal, parish of Erbstetten (see 15025. *Kleinknecht*, 1, v.), with Agness Klöpferin of Schöntal as sponsor.<sup>[14]</sup> Marga-

retha died at Erbstetten on 19 June 1626, aged 56 years, 4 months, and 7 days. She was buried the next day.<sup>[15]</sup> Lienhardt was married secondly on 8 April 1627 at Erbstetten to **Barbara Michelhans**, daughter of Caspar Michelhans.<sup>[16]</sup> She was born about 1596, and died at Erbstetten on 2 August 1636, aged 40 years.<sup>[17]</sup>

3. **Hans<sup>H</sup> Ackermann**<sup>[31]</sup> (*Lienhardt<sup>1/1</sup>*), of Erbstetten, was baptized as Johannes at Erbstetten on 1 November 1581, with Peter Kerns of Erbstetten as his sponsor.<sup>[32]</sup> He had died as an inhabitant of Erbstetten before 6 May 1649, when his daughter Martha was married.<sup>[33]</sup> He first married, at Erbstetten on 18 May 1602, **Anna Klöpfer**. She was the daughter of Jos Klöpfer of Mittelschönthal.<sup>[34]</sup> She died at Erbstetten on 7 November 1608, apparently as the result of a pregnancy (*puerpa*).<sup>[35]</sup> Hans married second, at Erbstetten on 23 April 1609, **Barbara Seitz**.<sup>[36]</sup> She was baptized at Erbstetten on 3 December 1588, daughter of Bastion and Anna (\_\_\_\_) Seitz, and sponsored by Barbara, widow of Lentz Hildebrand of Erbstetten.<sup>[37]</sup> Barbara died and was buried at Erbstetten on 9 August 1626, aged 38 years.<sup>[38]</sup> Hans married third, at Erbstetten on 22 January 1627, **Anna**

**(Fischer) Klöpfer.**<sup>[39]</sup> She was the daughter of the late Michael Fischer of Grossaspach, who had already died when she had first married **Michael Klöpfer** at Erbstetten on 25 August 1622.<sup>[40]</sup> Michael was baptized at Erbstetten on 4 August 1587, son of Zeÿr and Catharina (Eberlin) Klöpfer of Mittelschöntal, and sponsored by the pastor of Erbstetten.<sup>[41]</sup> Michael died as an inhabitant of Mittelschöntal on 31 July 1626, aged 35 years, and was buried at Erbstetten on 1 August.<sup>[42]</sup> Anna was an inhabitant of Erbstetten, and died after 11 July 1655, when she sponsored a child's baptism there.<sup>[43]</sup>

4. **Hans<sup>H</sup> Ackermann**<sup>[81]</sup> (*Lienhardt<sup>H-I/J</sup>*), of Erbsetten, known as “jung” Hans to distinguish him from his uncle (3), was baptized as “Johs” at Erbsetten on 28 January 1602. The parish pastor, Conrad Beringer, also sponsored his baptism.<sup>[82]</sup> Hans died at Erbsetten on 25 February 1635.<sup>[83]</sup> His wife, **Ursula** \_\_\_\_, was probably the mother of all his children, although only the latter three are so documented. She was born about 1609, and died at Erbsetten on 4 February 1683, aged

74 years, and buried two days later, as widow of Hanns Ackermann.<sup>[84]</sup> She also was married secondly on 31 January 1636 to **Caspar Michelhannß**,<sup>[85]</sup> but had no recorded children with him.

5. **Lienhardt<sup>G</sup> Ackermann**<sup>[92]</sup> (*Hans<sup>H</sup>, Lienhardt<sup>I-IJ</sup>*), of Erbstetten, was born about 1629. In a census of the parish, taken about 1632, he appears with his father, aged 3.<sup>[93]</sup> He died at Erbstetten on 9 December 1670, aged 41 years.<sup>[94]</sup> He was married at Erbstetten on 3 May 1659 to **Anna Maria Nantz**, daughter of Hans Nantz of “Imbensweilerhof.”<sup>[95]</sup> She was born by calculation about 2 November 1640, and was buried at Erbstetten on 23 April 1717, aged 76 years, 5 months, and 3 weeks.<sup>[96]</sup> She married secondly, at Erbstetten on 30 May 1671, “jung” **Hans Bürck**, son of “alt” Hans Bürck of Erbstetten (see *1915 Bürck*, 1, i.).<sup>[97]</sup> He was born about September 1649, and died at Erbstetten on 17 March 1730, aged 80 years and 6 months.<sup>[98]</sup>

Children of Lienhardt<sup>G</sup> and Anna Maria (Nantz) Ackermann, baptized at Erbstetten, are:
