

## 30405. **BÜHLER**

1. **Hans<sup>K</sup> Bühler**, of Fornsbach in the parish of Murrhardt, Württemberg, died before 21 February 1575, when his daughter Anna was married. He is identified from the marriage records of his children. Württemberg was a duchy from 1495 to 1806, and ruled Fornsbach from 1504<sup>[1]</sup>

Known children of Hans<sup>K</sup> Bühler include:

- i. MARTIN BÜHLER, m. Murrhardt 24 April 1576 CATHARINA WESNER, dau. of Hanß Wesner of Kirnberg.<sup>[2]</sup>
- + ii. ANNA<sup>J</sup> BÜHLER, m. Murrhardt 21 Feb. 1575 JACOB RAISER, son of Bartlin Raiser of Murrhardt<sup>[3]</sup> (see 7601. *Raiser*, 2).
