

## 1915. BÜRCK

1. **Hans<sup>H</sup> Bürck**,<sup>[1]</sup> known as “alt” Hans to distinguish him from his son, died at Erbstetten, duchy of Württemberg, on 3 February 1680, and was buried the following day. His age was not recorded.<sup>[2]</sup> His wife was **Eva** \_\_\_\_, who was born about 1620, and died on 4 March 1690, aged 70 years.<sup>[3]</sup> She is directly identified as the mother only of Hans’s three youngest children. Their origin is suggested by the baptismal record of the first of these children: “*von Altkirch im Sontgau gelegen.*”<sup>[4]</sup> Altkirch in Sundgau is located in southern Alsace, near Schweighof. Erbstetten was ruled by the counts of Württemberg, beginning in 1453.<sup>[5]</sup> The county became a duchy in 1495, and so remained until 1806.<sup>[6]</sup>

Children of Hans<sup>H</sup> Bürck, possibly not by Eva and in uncertain birth order, are:

Erbstetten 30 May 1671 ANNA MARIA<sup>C</sup> (NANTZ) ACKERMANN,<sup>[9]</sup> dau. of Hans Nantz of “Imbsenweilerhof,” and widow of Lienhardt Ackermann of Erbstetten<sup>[10]</sup> (see 939, 3779. *Ackermann*, 5), b. ca. 2 Nov. 1640, d. Erbstetten 23 April 1717, aged 76y 5m 3w.<sup>[11]</sup>
2. ii. HANS CONRAD<sup>C</sup> BÜRCK, b. ca. 1650, d. 21 April 1683, m. MARIA (\_\_\_\_) BACHER.
- iii. CATHARINA BÜRCK,<sup>[12]</sup> b. say 1655, inhabitant of Backnang, Württemberg, d. before 8 May 1688, when her husband remarried,<sup>[13]</sup> m. (1) Erbstetten 24 Jan. 1675 HANS MAUSINGER,<sup>[14]</sup> b. Backnang 27 Dec. 1654, son of Martin and Catharina (Groß) Mausinger, sp. H. Daniel Rechberger, Ursula, widow of M. N. Dünckederker, and Maria, widow of Martin Beltz,<sup>[15]</sup> d. Backnang 8, bur. 9 Aug. 1725, aged 71y 8m.<sup>[16]</sup>

- iv. JOSEPH BÜRCK, b. say 1657, m. Unterweissach, Württemberg, 31 May 1681 CATHARINA PFÄHLER,<sup>[17]</sup> b. 24 Sept. 1655, dau. of Jacob and Barbara (\_\_\_\_) Pfähler of Hohnweiler, sp. Peter Kibler and wife Apollonia of Hohnweiler.<sup>[18]</sup>

Children of Hans<sup>H</sup> and Eva (\_\_\_\_) Bürck, born and baptized at Erbstetten, are:

- v. MARGARETHA BÜRCK,<sup>[19]</sup> b. 13 Jan. 1659, sp. Catharina, wife of the pastor M.I.G. [Joseph Gmelin], Ursula, wife of Christopher Lachner of Burgstall, and Margaretha, wife of Demas Müller,<sup>[20]</sup> d. Heiningen, parish of Backnang, 26, bur. Backnang 28 Feb. 1719, aged about (*ungefähr*) 61y,<sup>[21]</sup> m. Erbstetten 15 July 1679 HANS CHRISTOPH KÜBLER,<sup>[22]</sup> bp. Murrhardt, Württemberg, 13 March 1656, son of "alt" Jacob and Maria (\_\_\_\_) Kübler of Vorderwestermurr, sp. Hannß Georg Dentzel of Murrhardt and Leonhard Rauh of Vorderwestermurr,<sup>[23]</sup> d. Heiningen 19, bur. Backnang 21 April 1721, aged about (*ungefähr*) 64y.<sup>[24]</sup>
- vi. URSULA BÜRCK, b. 10 May 1661, sp. Demas Müller and wife Margaretha, the wife of Christoph Lachner of Burgstall, and Catharina, wife of the pastor.<sup>[25]</sup>
- vii. HANS GEORG BÜRCK, b. 4 July 1664, sp. M. Iosephus Gmelin, pastor, as proxy for his wife Catharina, Demas Vorschung of Erbstetten, and Jerg Steir,<sup>[26]</sup> as old Jerg d. Erbstetten 11 Feb. 1742, aged 77y,<sup>[27]</sup> m. Erbstetten 3 Nov. 1685 ANNA MARIA (\_\_\_\_) BARTH, widow of Hans Barth of Kirchberg,<sup>[28]</sup> called Anna, b. ca. 1654, d. Erbstetten 28 Feb. 1713, aged 59y;<sup>[29]</sup> m. (2) Erbstetten 31 Sept. 1713 JUDITHA TRÄNCKLIN, dau. of Hans Jerg Träncklin of Allmersbach,<sup>[30]</sup> who d. Erbstetten 22 Oct. 1749.<sup>[31]</sup>

2. **Hans Conrad<sup>G</sup> Bürck**<sup>[32]</sup> (*Hans<sup>H</sup>*), shepherd, was born about 1650. He died at Erbstetten on 21 April 1683, aged 33 years.<sup>[33]</sup> He married **Anna Maria (\_\_\_\_) Bacher**, called Maria, widow of Peter Bacher of Ungeheuerhof, parish of Backnang (see 1879. *Bacher*, 1), at Erbstetten on 20 February 1672.<sup>[34]</sup> She was born about 1640, died at Erbstetten on 3 September 1705, aged 65 years, and reportedly was survived by nine children.<sup>[35]</sup> Ungeheuerhof was part of Württemberg since 1442.<sup>[36]</sup>

Children of Hans Conrad<sup>G</sup> and Anna Maria (\_\_\_\_) BÜRCK, the first four born at Ungeheuerhof and baptized at Backnang, and the fifth born and baptized at Erbstetten, are:

- i. HANß CONRAD BÜRCK, as Conratus bp. 29 Aug. 1673, sp. Jerg Oettinger and wife Maria,<sup>[37]</sup> d. Ungeheuerhof 14 March 1674, aged 6m.<sup>[38]</sup>
- ii. ANNA ELISABETHA BÜRCK,<sup>[39]</sup> bp. 23 Feb. 1675, sp. Jerg Oettinger, shepherd, and wife Maria,<sup>[40]</sup> d. Waldrems, parish of Backnang, 4, bur. Backnang 6 Feb. 1743, aged 68y,<sup>[41]</sup> m. Erbstetten 26 Sept. 1697 JOHANN WILHELM KLEIN,<sup>[42]</sup> as Wilhelm, younger twin of Johannes, bp. Backnang 18 May 1673, sons of Hans and Barbara (\_\_\_\_) Klein of Waldrems, both sp. Martin Haag and wife Anna,<sup>[43]</sup> d. Waldrems 8, bur. Backnang 10 June 1749, aged 73y.<sup>[44]</sup>
- iii. CONRAD BÜRCK,<sup>[45]</sup> b. 23 July 1677, sp. old Jerg Oettinger, shepherd, and wife Maria,<sup>[46]</sup> as old Conrad d. Erbstetten 3 Jan. 1744, aged 67y,<sup>[47]</sup> m. by 12 Aug. 1706 ANNA BARBARA \_\_\_\_\_,<sup>[48]</sup> reportedly the widow of Andreas Kühner of Neckarrems, b. ca. Dec. 1671, d. Erbstetten 29 May 1731, aged 59y 6m.<sup>[49]</sup>
- iv. MARGRETHA BÜRCK, b. 28 Aug. 1679, sp. old Jerg Oettinger, shepherd, and wife Maria,<sup>[50]</sup> d. Erbstetten 11 Sept. 1747, aged 68y,<sup>[51]</sup> m. Erbstetten 30 Oct. 1703 LEONHARD FALCK, son of the late Johannes Falck of Weikersheim,<sup>[52]</sup> b. ca. 1676, d. Erbstetten 28 Oct. 1729, aged 53y.<sup>[53]</sup>
- + v. CHRISTINA<sup>F</sup> BÜRCK, b. 21 July 1683, sp. Maria, wife of Georg Eitinger, shepherd of Backnang,<sup>[54]</sup> d. Erbstetten 26 Jan. 1741, aged 57y,<sup>[55]</sup> m. Erbstetten 30 Oct. 1703 JACOB THAIß,<sup>[56]</sup> b. Ruppertshofen, parish of Täferrot, Limpurg/Württemberg, 7 July 1674, son of Andreas and Barbara (Schailen) Thaiß, later of Erbstetten (see 957. *Thaiß*, 3), sp. Hannß Schmid of Ruppertshofen,<sup>[57]</sup> d. Erbstetten 14 April 1742, aged 70y.<sup>[58]</sup>
