

## 5. DAILEY

1. **Owen<sup>1</sup> Dailey** was born in Ireland, and is supposed to have moved his family from there to “Deloit” [Beloit?], Wisconsin. His name is known only from his son’s death certificate, and his wife has not been identified. Children of Owen<sup>1</sup> Dailey are:

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  - i. JAMES EDWARD<sup>2</sup> DAILEY, b. 20 June 1863, d. 6 May 1938, m. LUCILE CARTER.
  - ii. PETER DAILEY, noted in the family as a performer.

2. **James Edward<sup>2</sup> Dailey<sup>[2]</sup> (Owen<sup>1</sup>)**, was born 20 June 1863. His death certificate says that he was born in Rockton, Winnebago County, Illinois,<sup>[3]</sup> but he is traditionally believed to be native to Ireland. He died 6 May 1938 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois,<sup>[4]</sup> having married, 10 June 1909 in Chicago, **Lucile Carter**.<sup>[5]</sup> She was born 27 July 1878 in St. Joseph, Buchanan County, Missouri, daughter of Horace Waldo and Jean C. (Willmarth) Carter (see 23. *Willmarth*, 8, i.), and died 18 February 1948 in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, California.<sup>[6]</sup>
