

1919. DANNENHAUER

1. **Hans Bernhardt^H Dannenhauer** first appears at Steinenberg, Württemberg, but moved permanently to Asperglen in the parish of Oppelsbohm in the early 1650s. He died before 7 September 1693, probably at Asperglen,^[1] but sacraments in the parish are not recorded consistently from 1685 through 1694. His first known wife, **Barbara** ____, was the mother of all the children born to him from 1641 to 1661. As a widower, Bernhardt married at Asperglen on 1 September 1672 **Catharina** (____) **Landmann** of Grossheppach, former wife (*gescheiders Ehefrau*) of Hanß Landmann of Rudersberg.^[2] The deaths of Bernhardt and his wives are not recorded at Asperglen. Steinenberg was ruled by the county of Württemberg from 1372, via the overlordship of the landed possessions of the Lorch monastery.^[3] The county also ruled Asperglen as early as 1369.^[4] The county was raised to a duchy in 1495, and remained one until 1806.^[5]

2. Hans Conrad^G Dannenhauer (*Hans Bernhardt^H*), of Birkenweissbuch, parish of Oppelsbohm, was born at Steinenberg on 19 September 1645. He was baptized at Schorndorf, *in exilio*, and

sponsored by M. J. Conrad Keppelmann, pastor of Steinenberg.^[39] He was buried at Oppelsbohm on 11 October 1705, in his 63rd year.^[40] He married **Margaretha Haller** at Asperglen on 20 April 1669.^[41] She was born at Weissbuch, parish of Oppelsbohm, on 29 October 1647, daughter of Hans and Genovea (____) Haller (see 3839, 7653. *Haller*, 2, iii.). At her baptism, the sponsors were Jacob Häfelin of Birkenweissbuch and Elisabetha, wife of Hanß Menges of Schorndorf.^[42] Margaretha was also an inhabitant of Birkenweissbuch, and was buried at Oppelsbohm on 28 August 1728, aged 89 years [*sic*].^[43] The Weissbuch region was named by 1326, and was another of the possessions of Lorch that came under the control of Württemberg in 1372. Birkenweissbuch was distinguished from Vorder- and Hinterweissbuch by 1524.^[44]

3. **Anna Maria^F Dannenhauer** (*Hans Conrad^G, Bernhardt^H*) was born about 1693, and died at Birkenweissbuch on 25 April 1775, aged 82 years.^[68] At Birkenweissbuch on 9 July 1720, she married **Johannes Wegscheider**, "Johan Wegscheiders eines Marquetreters ehel: Sohn." Johannes's father is otherwise unrecorded in Oppelsbohm parish records.^[69] Johannes was born about November 1691, and died at Birkenweissbuch on 16 February 1776, aged 84 years and 3 months.^[70]
