

## 3727. ELLINGER

1. **Leonhard<sup>H</sup> Ellinger<sup>[1]</sup>** was an inhabitant of Neustetten, parish of Murrhardt, duchy of Württemberg.<sup>[2]</sup> His parentage is uncertain, and he is mainly documented by records of the first marriages of his children. The latest such record, of Georg, is dated 1633; it indicates that Leonhard was still alive in the spring of that year. Neustetten was the property of the monastery at Murrhardt as early as 1575. The village's civil jurisdiction was transferred to Kirchenkirnberg by 1809, and it was renamed "Unterneustetten" to distinguish it from "Oberneustetten," a filial of the parish of Kirchenkirnberg.<sup>[3]</sup>
