59. FREYTAG

The basic account of this family in print is by Burkhart Oertel, based on the *Ortssippenbücher* (local family registers) and *Einwohnerbücher* (registers of inhabitants) of the parish of Backnang. However, the position of Johann Georg Freytag (1692–1757) has been disputed. In the *Einwohnerbuch*, it is stated that he was the one born in 1696, son of Johann Heinrich Freytag of Waldrems.^[1] Oertel questions this placement, evidently on chronological grounds. Based on Georg's age, 65 years less 6 weeks, when he died on 8 May 1757, Oertel calculates his birth date to about 19 June 1692. However, Oertel was unable to locate another Georg of similar birth date who was baptized in the parish.^[2]

This local emphasis, together with the lack of a local record of his first marriage (which should have named his father), seems to have discouraged researchers from extending research to surrounding areas. Robert Mack approached the issue with no such restraint. In the nearby parish of Erbstetten, he found another candidate, baptized on the exact day that the Backnang death register had suggested.^[3] This Georg's father, Michael, was Heinrich's brother.^[4] Mack also reports that Georg was married in 1713 at "Sulzbach," but does not show his wife's name. Nor does Mack pursue Georg further.^[5]

Nevertheless, Oertel would lead us to expect that Georg's wife was named Margaretha, and that their children included a daughter named Anna Maria, neither of whom is found in Backnang before 1719. In fact, Mack refers directly to the marriage record showing that Michael's son Georg was married to Margaretha, daughter of Michael Nothurff of Zwerenberg. Where Georg and Margaretha lived from 1713 to 1718 remains unknown, and between 1719 and 1722 they had no children in Waldrems who lived long enough to be baptized. However, Georg's first child with his second wife was sponsored by Joh. Michäel Notturff of Schleißweiler, which, like Zwerenberg, was in the parish of Sulzbach an der Murr. This seems to represent continued association with the family of Georg's first wife, and might also reflect the regional practice of enlisting the same sponsors for all children of the same parents, regardless of remarriage.

The main residences of members of this family were all formerly part of the southwest German state of Württemberg. It was a county before 1495, a duchy from 1495 to 1806, and a kingdom from 1806 to 1918. Its territorial jurisdiction expanded through the medieval and early modern periods, and in 1806 it absorbed and assumed the overlordship of several smaller states. [10] However, Württemberg came to rule *Backnang* (nos. 6, 7) and the surrounding areas relatively early. Though Backnang originally belonged to the duchy of Baden, it passed to Württemberg by the early fourteenth century. [11] In 1439, *Heiningen* (nos. 1, 2) and *Waldrems* (nos. 1, 2, 4, 5) were among the fiefs pledged by the counts of Württemberg as of the castle of Reichenberg. [12] *Erbstetten* (no. 3) also came under Württemberg rule by 1453. [13] *Sulzbach an der Murr*, with its possessions including *Schleißweiler* and *Zwerenberg* (no. 4), was ruled by the counts of Löwenstein until Württemberg took it by conquest in 1504. [14]

1. **Josua^H Freytag**^[15] (?Hans^I) was born about 1607. As an inhabitant of Waldrems, he was buried in Backnang on 18 November 1677, aged 70 years.^[16] However, when his children were born, the family lived at Heiningen. The mother of the first three children was **Agnes** _____. By 1643 his wife was **Engel** _____, sometimes *Engla*. She was born about 1604, also last an inhabitant of Waldrems, and buried at Backnang on 21 November 1680, aged 76 years.^[17]

She was baptized at Erbstetten on 5 April 1654, daughter of old Martin and Martha (Ackermann) Kübler (see 1889. Kübler, 2, iii.), with sponsor Anna Dorothea, wife of H. Jacob Kuppisch of Grossaspach. Anna Maria died on 27 September 1716 at Erbstetten, aged 63 years, and was buried 29 September. She had first married, at Erbstetten on 20 February 1677, young Hans Sanzenbacher. He was baptized at Erbstetten on 24 June 1655, son of old Hans and Margaretha (Lautterwachter) Sanzenbacher of Erbstetten, with Martin Kübler as his sponsor. He was buried 10 May 1757 at Backnang.[101] He first married Margaretha Noturff at Sulzbach an der Murr, Württemberg, on 25 July 1713.[102] She was born at Zwerenberg in that parish, and was baptized at Sulzbach on 15 February 1691, daughter of Hanß Michael and Anna (Herold) Noturff, with Jacob Weller and his wife Margaretha of Zwerenberg as sponsors.[103] She died at Waldrems on 3 September 1722, aged about (bei) 30 years, with an unborn child. She was buried two days later at Backnang. [104] Georg married secondly, on 13 April 1723 at Backnang, Margaretha Baÿ, with a record that reads: "Johann Georg Freÿtag Bauer und Wittwer zu Waldrems und Margaretha <u>Baÿin</u> von Alfdorf:" No other information is recorded, even though—as Oertel notes—such records usually show whether the bride was a single woman or a widow.[105] However, in the birth records of their first three children, Baÿ is denoted geb.—her birth surname. Margaretha therefore appears to be the one born at Alfdorf, Württemberg, on 30 March 1698, daughter of Jacob "jun." and Margretha (Kolb) Baÿ of that place (see 945. Baÿ, 3, vi.), and sponsored at baptism by Hanß Luttel and wife Ursula. [106] Margaretha died at Waldrems on 9 November 1774, aged 76 years, 7 months, and 10 days, with a record that incorrectly names her as the widow of Johann

Sponsors were Matthaus Siber and his wife Maria Catharina, of Unterweissach.^[143] She died an inhabitant of Waldrems on 22 May 1760, aged 37 years and 8 weeks, and was buried 24 May.^[144] Michael married second, at Backnang on 27 January 1761, **Maria Catharina Treffz**.^[145] She was born at Fürstenhof, Württemberg, on 16 October 1731, daughter of Johann Michael and Elisabetha Catharina (Specht) Treffz (see 473. *Treffz*, 4, v.). The date of her baptism at Rietenau, Württemberg, is not specified, but baptisms in that parish had customarily occurred on the day of the child's birth; her sponsors were Hanß Jacob Beck and [his wife] Anna Maria of Backnang, and Margretha Aichelin.^[146] Catharina appears to have survived her husband, but her later history is not known.

days.^[209] He married **Maria Dorothea Jeitter** on 10 May 1836 at Backnang.^[210] She was born at Buhlbronn in the parish of Oppelsbohm, Württemberg, on 7 November 1808, daughter of Jacob and Anna Catharina (Kamm) Jeitter (see 119. Jeitter, 7, i.), afterwards of Kallenberg, Württemberg. Sponsors at her baptism at Oppelsbohm on 9 November were Paul Klotz of Birkenweissbuch and his wife, *née* Dorothea Weber of Welzheim.^[211] Dorothea died on 14 September 1873 at Backnang, aged 64 years, 10 months and 8 days.^[212] After Ludwig died she married secondly, at Backnang on 29 June 1856, **Johann Georg Ade** of Maubach.^[213] He was born at Maubach and baptized at Backnang on 29 August 1789, son of Christian and Christina Magdalena (Blind) Ade. The sponsors at his baptism were Melchior Specht, *Schultheiß* of Maubach, and his wife Margaretha.^[214] Georg died at Maubach on 2 February 1859, aged 69 years, 5 months, and 3 days.^[215] He also had children with a previous spouse, and no children with Dorothea.
