

15329. GRAU

1. **Jacob^J Grau**, of Oberndorf, died between 1584 and 1592. He is known from the marriage records of his children. Oberndorf was known as “upper Rudersberg” (Latin, *Rudolfesberg superius*) in 1245, when both fees were confirmed by the pope to the monastery at Backnang. They also were both conveyed to the county of Württemberg in 1459. The name Oberndorf was in use by 1400.^[1] The county became a duchy in 1495 and remained one until 1806.^[2]

- iii. ANNA GRAU,^[11] b. ca. 1552, d. Oberndorf 10 Dec. 1622, aged 70y,^[12] m. Rudersberg 17 Feb. 1584 HANS HAUBER, son of old Hans Hauber of Oberndorf,^[13] b. ca. 1554, d. Oberndorf 12 Dec. 1628, aged 74y.^[14]
- iv. HANS GRAU,^[15] b. ca. 1561, d. Oberndorf 24 Sept. 1621,^[16] aged 60y, m. (1) Rudersberg 14 Aug. 1581 ANNA RAPP, dau. of Leonhard Rapp of Oberndorf,^[17] d. Rudersberg 16 Nov. 1596;^[18] m. (2) Rudersberg 28 March 1597 BRIGITTA SCHAAL, dau. of Nicolai Schaal of Oberndorf,^[19] inhabitant of Oberndorf, living 15 Oct. 1598.^[20]
- + v. ENGLA^I GRAU,^[21] b. ca. 1574, d. Oberndorf 17 March 1614, aged 40y,^[22] m. Rudersberg 12 March 1592 HANS KLOTZ, son of the late Leonhard Klotz of Oberndorf^[23] (see 479, 30493. *Klotz*, 2), d. Oberndorf 28 Aug. 1635.^[24]
