

3839, 7653. HALLER

1. **Jerg¹ Haller** died at Birkenweissbuch in the parish of Oppelsbohm, duchy of Württemberg, on 26 March 1617.^[1] He was married to **Gretha** _____, who was the mother of his younger children. She survived him and died, as Margretha, at Birkenweissbuch on 19 April 1624.^[2] She married secondly, at Birkenweissbuch on 10 January 1618, **Hannß Herkhel**,^[3] who survived her, and re-married at Birkenweissbuch on 1 August 1624.^[4] The Weissbuch region was under the control of Württemberg from 1372, due to its overlordship of the monastery of Adelberg, but Birkenweissbuch was not separately identified until 1524.^[5] Württemberg was a county until 1495, and then a duchy until 1806.^[6]

2. **Hans^H Haller** (*Jerg¹*) was born as Johannes on 2 February 1616 at Birkenweissbuch. The sponsor at his baptism was M. Thomas Rommel, pastor.^[17] Hans died at Birkenweissbuch on 25

November 1667, aged 51 years, and was buried two days later.^[18] He first married **Genovea** ____ at Weissbuch in June 1642; her maiden name is not of record.^[19] She was born about 1617, and died at Birkenweissbuch on 19 February 1665, aged 48 years.^[20] Hans married second, at Birkenweissbuch on 29 May 1666, **Anna Klein**, daughter of the late Georg Klein of Weiler zum Stein, Württemberg.^[21]
