

25. HARKER

1. **Enoch¹ Harker** was born 28 June 1804^[1] in New Jersey.^[2] He died 10 April 1867, aged 62 years, 9 months and 13 days, and was buried in Shiloh Cemetery in Goshen Township, Clermont County, Ohio.^[3] He reportedly committed suicide by taking laudanum.^[4] On 21 February 1826 he married **Christiana Sheets** in Salem County, New Jersey.^[5] She was born in New Jersey in about 1805.^[6] She died 13 April 1861, aged 56 years, and was also buried in Shiloh Cemetery.^[7] They are credited with six sons and three daughters.^[8] On 9 April 1867, at the age of 62 years, Enoch applied for a license to marry Rachael F. Hughes, aged 40 years, in Clermont County.^[9] Because he died the next day, however, it is unlikely that the projected marriage took place.

Enoch removed from Salem County, New Jersey, to Butler County, Ohio, in 1830.^[10] In 1840 his family, residing there, included one male under 5, two males aged 5-9, two males aged 10-14, one male aged 30-39, two females under 5, and two females aged 30-39.^[11] By 1850 Enoch had removed to Goshen Township, Clermont County, Ohio, although his eldest son David remained behind.

2. **David Sheets² Harker** (*Enoch*¹) was born 22 January 1827 in Gloucester County, New Jersey.^[48] He died on 16 January 1907, aged 79 years, 11 months and 25 days, at his home in Ward Township, Randolph County, Indiana, one mile north of Deerfield, where he had lived since
