## 7619, 7639. HEBERLIN

1. **Jacob<sup>I</sup> Heberlin**, of Buhlbronn, Württemberg, was born about 1578, and died at Buhlbronn on 8 May 1628, aged about 50 years.<sup>[1]</sup> He married **Katharina** \_\_\_\_\_ by 1614. They seem to have had some children whose births were not recorded. Katharina married secondly, at Buhlbronn on 1 August 1630, **Jerg Ehmann** of Haubersbronn, Württemberg.<sup>[2]</sup> As his widow, Katharina married third, at Buhlbronn on 10 February 1639, **Hanß Michel**, son of Clauß Michel.<sup>[3]</sup> The feudal fee of Buhlbronn was held of the count of Württemberg as early as 1411.<sup>[4]</sup> The county was raised to a duchy in 1495, and then to a kingdom from 1806 to 1918.<sup>[5]</sup>

Children of Jacob<sup>1</sup> and Katharina (\_\_\_\_) Heberlin, probably all born at Buhlbronn, but only the first two thus recorded at Oppelsbohm, are:

- i. LIENHARDT HEBERLIN, b. 24 June 1614, sp. Caspar Frach of Schorndorf and Apolonia, wife of Jerg Münsch,<sup>[6]</sup> d. 26 Aug. 1614, aged 9w.<sup>[7]</sup>
- ii. ELISABETHA HEBERLIN, b. 25 July 1617, sp. Joannes \_\_\_\_, *Schultheiß* of Haubersbronn, and the wife of Jerg Mensch.<sup>[8]</sup>
- iii. URSULA<sup>H</sup> HEBERLIN, b. say 1620, inhabitant of Buhlbronn, d. after 27 May 1659,<sup>[9]</sup> m. Buhlbronn 28 Jan. 1644 MARTIN FRITZ,<sup>[10]</sup> b. Welzheim Württemberg, 30 July 1620, son of Leonhardt and Ursula (Maier) Fritz (see 3809, 3819. Fritz, 2), sp. Martin Conlin of Welzheim,<sup>[11]</sup> inhabitant of Buhlbronn, d. after 16 Nov. 1680.<sup>[12]</sup>
  - iv. JACOB HEBERLIN, inhabitant of Buhlbronn, d. 10 March 1636.<sup>[13]</sup>
