If the identification of Benjamin⁶ Van Vleet's father in my account of that family is correct (63. *Van Vleet*, 5), then his mother could hardly be anyone other than Annatje Heemstraat. Jonathan Pearson, an early student of the families associated with the Dutch Reformed churches in Schenectady and Albany, New York, was unable to identify her in his initial work on Schenectady.^[1] When he proceeded to compile his Albany genealogies, he did not fully correlate this work with his earlier research. As a result, the presence of only one unmarried woman of this complete name at Schenectady by 1788 was not noted in Pearson's accounts of the Heemstraat family.

Once that circumstance is taken into account, the placement of Annatje as the daughter of Jacob Heemstraat and his wife Catharine Dret (De Ret), who married at Albany in 1763, seems reasonably secure.^[2] This, however, is not the end of Pearson's difficulties, for he was uncertain as to the identification of Jacob. He identified Catherine's husband tentatively as Jacob⁴ Heemstraat (*Johannes*³, *Dirk*², *Takel*¹ *Dirkse*), but a closer look at the documentation inspires more confidence.^[3] Jacob was baptized on 15 May 1743, nearly the latest plausible date.^[4] His father, Johannes, had two brothers who lived to marry: Takel, who married in 1734 but whose children's baptisms show no interruption until after 1745,^[5] and Jacob, who had children with another wife both before and after the marriage of Catharine Dret.^[6] Their father, Dirk, was the only surviving son of the immigrant.

Pearson's work is an invaluable resource for early Mohawk Valley genealogy, freely usable for collateral lineages and brief summaries of some Dutch-language documents. It is nevertheless important to realize that Pearson did not correlate his findings with enough care to identify the wife of Benjamin⁵ Van Vliet. This essay seeks to bring all available documentation to bear upon the descent of Annatje Heemstraat.

1. **Takel¹ Dirkse Heemstraat** and his wife, **Maritie** ____, were admitted as members of the Reformed Dutch Church in Albany by the end of the year 1683.^[7] They are last recorded as of Albany, on 7 February 1716/7, as shown below. Their appearances in the records are sparse. On 19 March 1682/3, Zacharias Seckels agreed to herd cattle at New Albany, "yielding all obedience to the worthy Willem Gysbertsz and the worthy Tackel Dircksz as his masters and principals in this regard."^[8] On 23 Feb. 1684/5, Marten Crygier, junior, and Taeckel Dircksz "in love and friendship they have contracted and agreed" for Taeckel to lease a farm, to wit, twenty morgens of land at Canastagioene, from Jan Clute's fence along the path and on the other side along the

fence, with Taeckel to clear and work the land along the fence, with a house, barn, and rick, four milch cows, and two horses, to begin 16 April 1685 and continue for eight years. The witnesses were G. Swartt and Pieter Mingael.^[9] On 21 February 1706/7 Takell Derrickse of the city of Albany, yeoman, made a grant Terick Harmsen, carpenter, for £141. The land consisted of a lot and buildings standing on the west side of Brewer Street, bounded south by Pieter Winne, west by Johannis Mingael, and north by Cornelis Swits. He signed his name as Takel Dirks hiem Straet.^[10]

On 7 February 1716/7, Maritie appeared before four county justices of the peace to answer an action against her and her husband on account of "Some Dissatisfaction of words spoken by the s^d maritie severall times before the date hereof against Peter van Brugh & myndert Schuyler Esq^{rs}: for which words they enterd each an action against the said Takel Dirkse and maritie his wife each for five hundred pounds Damage." Maritie declared that she had not spoken ill of either of them and acknowledged the plaintiffs for honest men, whereupon the charges were withdrawn. Maritie promised to pay the charges accrued on the actions.^[11] By an act that passed 23 December 1717, the colonial legislature of New York agreed to pay and discharge several debts due from the colony, including one owed to Takel Dirkse for 38 ounces and 12½ penny-weight of plate.^[12]

Takel Dirksz was one of the witnesses at the baptism of a child of Adam Vroman and Grietje Takels, on 30 May 1697;^[13] and, as Takel Heemstraat, he appeared twice to sponsor a child of Ahasuerus Marselis and Sarah Heemstraat.^[14] Although Barbara, wife of Claes Fransen, was never referred to as "Takel's daughter," Takel nevertheless appeared to sponsor two of her children as well,^[15] and her surname at marriage was a variant of *Heemstraat*, a surname unknown in any other New Netherland family.^[16] Lastly, he sponsored two children of his son Dirk, as fully documented below.

It has been suggested that Maritie was belonged to a Vyselaar family, based on a woman of this name joining Takel to sponsor a child of Claes Fransen in 1703,^[17] and alternatively that she was Maritien Jans Dircksen, who received power of attorney from Dirck Dircksen on 17 July 1658 to collect from the West India Company at Amsterdam all the money due to his father from services in East India.^[18] More probably, the latter is was the one who married Jan Jansz Noorman as her second husband. They made a joint will on 21 April 1673 that mentions her

2. **Dirk² Takels Heemstraat** (*Takel¹ Dirkse*) was born in say 1675, based on his marriage at Albany on 3 November 1700 to **Claartje Quackenbosch**.^[36] She was the daughter of Johannes Quackenbosch and his wife Machteld (Jans?) Post, of Albany and Canastagione.^[37] They both sponsored his sister Sarah's child Johannes at baptism, 26 January 1701;^[38] Grietje Fransen on 9 February 1709, as stated above; and Johannes, son of Adriaan Kwakkenbos and Catharina Van Schaajk, on 27 October 1710.^[39] On 24 April 1707, the city of Albany granted to Dirck Takelsen a triangular lot of land without the northeast gate on the south side of the road to the river, bounded east by Gysbert Marselis and north [*sic*] and west by Heemstraet.^[40] This is the only known record that shows him in possession of land. In 1720 Derrick Takelsen was listed as one of the freeholders of the city and county of Albany, residing at Half Moon.^[41] The last known appearance of Dirk and Claartje was when they both appeared as sponsors for the baptism of Derk, first son of their son Johannes, on 9 May 1731 at Schenectady.^[42] They are otherwise named only in the baptisms of their own children, at Albany:^[43]

3. **Johannes³ Heemstraat** (*Dirk² Takels, Takel¹ Dirkse*) was baptized at Albany on 12 January 1709, with witnesses Jacobus Wyngaard and Neeltje Quackenbos.^[65] He appears to have married three times, from the naming of his deceased first wife in his second marriage record, and from records that designate his son Johannes both as "Jr." and as the husband of Elizabeth Bovie as late as 4 November 1773. From the same documentation, we surmise that the elder Johannes died no earlier than this date.^[66] He married first at Schenectady on 8 February 1730 **Bata Quackenbosch**, his cousin, when they were both of Connestigioune.^[67] She was baptized at Albany on 7 December 1707, daughter of Johannes Quackenbosch and his wife Anna Clute; her father was the brother of her mother-in-law.^[68] She died before 16 February 1750/1, when banns were first proclaimed for marriage between "Johannes Heemstraat wed'r van Bata Quackenbosch, en **Geertruy Busie** wed'r van Joh. Harines." They were married at Schenectady on 3 March 1750/1.^[69] She was baptized at Schenectady on 21 January 1710/1, daughter of Philip Busie and his wife Grietje Bratt.^[70] As above stated, Hannes Marinus and his wife Geertruid Busie had already sponsored the baptism of a niece of her future husband in 1738.^[71] She must have died before 3 October 1753, when Johannes Heamstreet obtained a license to marry **Elisabeth van der Volgen**.^[72] She was baptized 31 August 1723 at Schenectady, daughter of Tuenis van der Volgen and his wife Sara Harmens Freer.^[73]
