

## 1907. HORNUNG

1. **Jerg<sup>I</sup> Hornung**, of Buhlbronn, was living in 1636, when his son Jerg first married. No other record of him is known. The feudal fee of Buhlbronn was held of the count of Württemberg as early as 1411.<sup>[1]</sup> The county was raised to a duchy in 1495, and then to a kingdom in 1806.<sup>[2]</sup>

2. **Jerg<sup>H</sup> Hornung**<sup>[3]</sup> (*Jerg<sup>I</sup>*), of Buhlbronn, was born about 1611. He died near Welzheim, in a wagon accident, and his body was brought to Oppelsbohm and buried there on 31 May 1654. He was 43 years old.<sup>[4]</sup> He first married at Buhlbronn on 21 February 1636 **Ursula (Schwartz) Epplin**,<sup>[5]</sup> daughter of Thomas Schwartz of Steinenberg. She had first married Jerg Epplin at Buhlbronn on 21 February 1621.<sup>[6]</sup> There is no record of his parentage. Possibly he was the Jerg Epplin, *Septuagenarius*, who died at Buhlbronn 5 August 1635.<sup>[7]</sup> Because births in Buhlbronn went unrecorded from 1636 to 1639, a birth record for at least one of one of her children with her second husband is missing. She died at Buhlbronn on 31 January 1644.<sup>[8]</sup> Jerg married second, 30 June 1644 at Buhlbronn, **Agnes Kurtz**.<sup>[9]</sup> She was born at Buhlbronn on 28 March 1616, daughter of Jacob and Maria (\_\_\_\_) (Besler) Kurtz (see 7629, 7637. *Kurtz*, 1. b. i.). The sponsors at her baptism were Jacob Walther and Agnes, wife of the pastor.<sup>[10]</sup> Agnes died 14 October 1675 at Buhlbronn, aged 59 years and 6 months, and was buried the following day.<sup>[11]</sup> She married second, at Steinenberg on 9 July 1655, **Jacob Schwartz**, son of the late Jacob Schwartz of Steinenberg.<sup>[12]</sup> He lived at Buhlbronn after their marriage, and appears to have survived her.

3. **Jacob<sup>G</sup> Hornung**<sup>[37]</sup> (*Jerg<sup>H-1</sup>*), of Buhlbronn, was born 26 July 1650. The sponsor at his baptism was M. Michael Speidel, pastor.<sup>[38]</sup> As an inhabitant of Buhlbronn, Jacob was buried 17 May

1711 at Oppelsbohm.<sup>[39]</sup> He first married **Barbara Möll** on 10 August 1673 at Buhlbronn.<sup>[40]</sup> She was born 26 August 1655, daughter of Peter and Catharina (Dautel) Möll (see 3815. *Möll*, 1, x.), with M. Michael Speidel and his wife Catharina as sponsors.<sup>[41]</sup> Barbara was buried at Oppelsbohm, as an inhabitant of Buhlbronn, on 17 August 1694, aged 39 years.<sup>[42]</sup> She was the mother of all of Jacob's children. He married secondly, 9 April 1695 at Buhlbronn, **Anna Kühnlin**.<sup>[43]</sup> She was born 10 September 1673 at Oberschlechtbach, parish of Steinenberg, daughter of Christoph and Veronica (Häser) Kühnlin. The sponsors at her baptism were Jerg Wieler of Haubersbronn and his single daughter Agnes.<sup>[44]</sup> As an inhabitant of Buhlbronn, she was buried 10 March 1740 at Oppelsbohm, aged 66 years,<sup>[45]</sup> having married second, 31 May 1712 at Buhlbronn, Jerg Christoph Brecht.<sup>[46]</sup>
