

467. JUNG

1. **Michael^G Jung^[1]** was an inhabitant of Hohnweiler in the parish of Unterweissach (now Weissach im Tal), duchy of Württemberg.^[2] He died between 24 February 1677, when his wife, **Elisabetha** ____, died at Unterweissach,^[3] and 22 May 1678, when named as deceased (*nachgelassen*) in his daughter Anna's marriage record.^[4] The family's place of residence, Hohnweiler, was purchased by the counts of Württemberg in 1426 and afterwards held of them in fee.^[5]

- iv. ANNA JUNG, bp. 11 Jan. 1650, sp. Apolonia, wife of Peter Kibler of Hohnweiler,^[16] inhabitant of Hohnweiler, d. 10, bur. Unterweissach 11 May 1728, a widow,^[17] m. vi. JERG JUNG,^[21] bp. as Georg, 12 April 1658, sp. Michel, son of Peter Kibler,^[22] inhabitant of Hohnweiler, d. 14, bur. Unterweissach 17 May 1729, aged 71y 4w,^[23] m. Unterweissach 23 Aug. 1681 MARGARETHA KURTZ,^[24] bp. 17 Feb. 1653, dau. of Jacob and Barbara (Weckher) Kurtz of Hohnweiler (see 1873. *Weckher*, 1, iii.), sp. Hans Sigel and his wife Agatha of Däffern,^[25] inhabitant of Hohnweiler, d. 26, bur. Unterweissach 27 May 1729, aged 76y 13w 6d.^[26]

2. **Jacob^F Jung**^[27] (*Michael^C*), of Hohnweiler, was baptized at Unterweissach on 16 February 1652, sponsored by Peter Kübler of Hohnweiler.^[28] He died, an inhabitant of Hohnweiler and a widower, on 21 March 1733, aged 81 years, 1 month and 4 days, and was buried at Unterweissach.^[29] He married, at Unterweissach on 31 July 1677, **Barbara Holtzwarth**.^[30] She was born, by calculation, and baptized 31 August 1655 at Unterweissach, daughter of Jacob and Margaretha (____) Holtzwarth of Unterbrüden in the same parish (see 1869. *Holtzwarth*, 1, iii.). Her sponsor at baptism was Barbara, wife of David Hildebrand of Unterweissach.^[31] As an inhabitant of Hohnweiler, she died on 4 February 1721, aged 65 years, 5 months and 4 days. She was buried the following day at Unterweissach.^[32]

3. **Hans Melchior^E Jung^[59]** (*Jacob^F, Michael^G*), of Hohnweiler, was baptized at Unterweissach on 28 November 1681, with Abraham Füchtner and Maria his wife, of Wattenweiler, as sponsors.^[60] He died on 11 October 1763, and was buried at Unterweissach on 13 October 1763.^[61] He married **Anna Kugler** at Unterweissach on 15 June 1706.^[62] She was baptized at Murrhardt, Würt-

temberg, on 12 June 1686, daughter of Matthäus and Margaretha (Wurst) Kugler of Mettelberg in that parish (see 935. *Kugler*, 2, v.). The sponsor at her baptism was Eva, wife of Hanß Schortlin of Ruophöfle.^[63] As an inhabitant of Hohnweiler, she died on 30 March 1771, aged 84 years and 9 months. She was buried at Unterweissach on 1 April 1771.^[64]
