

239. KAMM

1. **Hans¹ Kamm** was an inhabitant of Winnenden in the duchy of Württemberg. He is known only from the 1610 marriage record of his son Jacob, in which Hans is named as deceased. The city was named as early as 1181, and the county of Württemberg acquired it by purchase in 1325.^[1] The county was raised to a duchy in 1495, and then to a kingdom from 1806 to 1918.^[2]

2. **Jacob¹ Kamm**^[3] (*Hans¹*), of Winnenden, died of the plague (*peste*) and was buried at Winnenden on 6 October 1611.^[4] He married at Winnenden on 15 April 1610 **Maria Schuch**.^[5] She was born on 11 June 1591 at Schwaikheim, Württemberg, daughter of Hans and Dorothea (____) Schuch (see 15297. *Schuch*, 1, iv.). The sponsors were Gilg Schäffer and Anna, wife of Jerg Khöltz.^[6] Maria died at Winnenden on 14 May 1655, aged 75 years [*sic*].^[7] She married secondly at Winnenden on 3 May 1612 **Michael Mann** (*Mahn*).^[8] He was born 22 June 1587 at Winnenden, son of Michael and Catharina (Welsch) Mann, and sponsored by Samßon Braun.^[9] He survived Maria and remarried, at Winnenden on 11 November 1655, to Catharina, widow of Sambson Pfehler of Bürg.^[10] When Michael died is not known.

3. **Hans Bernhardt^H Kamm**^[37] (*Jacob^l, Hans^l*) was born, as Johannes Bernhardus, at Winnenden on 22 February 1611. The sponsor at his baptism was Bernhard Wilhelm of Schnellenbach.^[38] He died at Winnenden on 31 April 1673 [*sic*], aged 62 years.^[39] He was first married at Winnenden on 4 September 1636 to **Catharina Schmidt**, daughter of Hans Schmidt of Oppelsbohm, Würt-

temberg.^[40] She was born about 1611, and died at Winnenden on 5 August 1663, aged 52 years.^[41] Bernhardt married secondly, at Winnenden on 28 February 1664, **Catharina Flindt**.^[42] She was born at Rudersberg, Württemberg, on 4 May 1630, daughter of Hans and Anna (____) Flindt. The sponsors at her baptism were Melcher Klontz and his wife Anna.^[43] After Bernhardt's death, she married secondly, at Rudersberg on 3 March 1674, Wilhelm Ackermann of that place, and went to live there.^[44] She was buried at Rudersberg as Wilhelm's widow on 11 September 1684, aged 54 years.^[45]

November 1649. The sponsor at his baptism was David Pfeleiderer.^[87] He was buried at Winnenden on 18 March 1694, aged 44 years.^[88] He married **Agatha Gockenbach** on 14 September 1675 at Hertmannsweiler in the same parish. She was the daughter of Hans Gockenbach, *Schultheiß* (appointed village mayor) of Oppelsbohm.^[89] She was the mother of all of Jacob's children, and seems to have survived him, but when she died and whether she remarried is not known.

4. **Andreas^F Kamm**^[98] (*Jacob^G, Hans Bernhardt^H, Jacob^I, Hans^I*) was born at Winnenden on 29 November 1682. At his baptism, the sponsors were Michael Sprösser and Anna Catharina, wife of H. Kraus.^[99] He died as an inhabitant of Bretzenacker, parish of Oppelsbohm, and was buried on 5 December 1752 at Oppelsbohm, aged 70 years less 7 days.^[100] He married **Maria Sommer** at Bretzenacker on 10 August 1706.^[101] She was born at Bretzenacker on 4 October 1684, daughter of Jerg and Eva (Besler) Sommer (see 1913. *Sommer*, 3, viii.), with sponsors H. Claas Herrman of Krehwinkel and Agnes, wife of Michael Brechenheim of Volkhardtsmühle.^[102] Maria died an inhabitant of Bretzenacker, and was buried at Oppelsbohm on 8 February 1760, aged 75 years, 3 months, and 1 day.^[103] Bretzenacker was a possession of the monastery of Lorch in 1293, when Württemberg assumed the overlordship of the monastery.^[104]

5. **Jacob^E Kamm**^[129] (*Andreas^F, Jacob^G, Hans Bernhardt^H, Jacob^I, Hans^J*) was born at Bretzenacker on 1 May 1719. The sponsors at his baptism were Johannes Kayßer and his wife Anna Barbara, of Rudersberg, and Maria Sommerin of Birkmannsweiler.^[130] Jacob died at Bretzenacker on 17 June 1773, aged 54 years.^[131] He married **Anna Catharina (Thaiß) Beßler** at Bretzenacker on 24 October 1747.^[132] She was born and baptized on 13 September 1719 at Erbstetten, Württemberg, daughter of Jacob and Christina (Bürck) Thaiß (see 957. *Thaiß*, 3, v.), and sponsored by Hiob Klein-knecht, his wife Dorothea, and the widow Margaretha Ackermännin.^[133] Catharina died as Jacob's widow on 19 December 1802 at Bretzenacker, aged 83 years.^[134] She had first married **Hanß Jerg Beßler**, a widower, at Bretzenacker on 24 September 1743.^[135] He was born at Bretzenacker on 21 April 1709, son of Hans Michel and Barbara (Auperlin) Beßler. The sponsors at his baptism were Johann Sommer and his wife Susanna.^[136] Jerg died at Bretzenacker on 23 March 1747, aged 37 years and 11 months.^[137] By the time his sons married, the standard spelling of their surname was *Bäßler*, and it is also the spelling with which their family records, deaths, and wives' deaths are recorded.
