

1473. KENDRICK

1. **George¹ Kendrick** married first, 23 April 1647 at Rehoboth, New Plymouth Colony (now Bristol County, Massachusetts), **Ruth Bowen**.^[1] She was born about 1626, probably in Wales, daughter of Richard Bowen by an unidentified wife,^[2] and was buried 31 October 1688 at Rehoboth.^[3] He married secondly, 1 April 1691 in Rehoboth, **Jane Ide**.^[4] She died as his wife, and was buried there on 12 April 1694.^[5]

- iii. SARAH KENDRICK, b. 12 April 1652; no further information.
- iv. ISAAC KENDRICK, b. 12 Feb. 1654[/5?],^[14] bur. Rehoboth 13 June 1675.^[15]
- v. MARY KENDRICK, b. 16 June 1659,^[16] d. Rehoboth 8 Feb. 1704/5,^[17] m. there 15 April 1685 SAMUEL BLISS,^[18] b. there 24 June 1660, son of Sgt. Jonathan and Rachel? (Puffer) Bliss,^[19] d. there 28 Aug. 1720.^[20]
- vi. ELIZABETH KENDRICK, b. 12 Sept. 1661,^[21] bur. Rehoboth 11 Feb. 1691/2,^[22] m. there 28 May 1689 JO-NAH PALMER,^[23] b. there 29 March 1662, son of Jonah Palmer,^[24] d. there 22 June 1710.^[25]
