1. **Leonhard**^{J/K} **Klotz**,^[1] of Oberndorf, parish of Rudersberg, died on 29 November 1579.^[2] He married **Margaretha** _____, who survived him, but she is not documented as the mother of those of his children who were born before the parish register begins in 1569. She died an inhabitant of Oberndorf on 23 August 1598.^[3] As his widow, she married old Lienhard Mantel at Rudersberg on 26 December 1580.^[4] This Lienhard died as an inhabitant of Rudersberg on 12 March 1603.^[5] Oberndorf was known as "upper Rudersberg" (Latin, *Rudolfesberg superius*) in 1245, when both fees were confirmed by the pope to the monastery at Backnang. They also were both conveyed from the monastery to the county of Württemberg in 1459. The name Oberndorf was in use by 1400.^[6] The county became a duchy in 1495 and remained one until 1806.^[7]

3. **Michael**^H **Klotz**^[61] (*Hans*^I, *Leonhard*^{J/K}), of Kallenberg in the parish of Rudersberg, Württemberg, was born at Oberndorf on 25 March 1602. The sponsor at his baptism was Lorentz Hauber.^[62] He died suddenly at Weissach, Württemberg, on 3 September 1659, aged 58 years.^[63] He was married at Rudersberg on the ninth Sunday after Trinity [24 July] 1633 to **Anna Rommel**, daughter

of Leonhardt Rommel of Kallenberg, [64] who appears to be the man who died at Kallenberg on 5 March 1636. [65] Anna was born about 1610. Recorded births at Kallenberg do not include hers, and no other children of Leonhardt are known. As an inhabitant of Kallenberg, and as Michael's widow, Anna was buried at Rudersberg on 19 May 1690, aged 80 years. [66] Kallenberg was ruled by Württemberg as early as 1403. In 1439, it was among the fiefs pledged by the counts, as possessions of the castle of Reichenberg. [67]

ber.^[85] From at least 1680 on, he was the appointed village mayor (*Schultheiß*). He first married **Anna Catharina Maisch** on 23 August 1664 at Rudersberg.^[86] She was the daughter of Jacob Maisch of Kaisersbach, parish of Welzheim, born about 1641, and was buried at Kallenberg on 27 September 1677, aged 36 years.^[87] Jerg married secondly **Anna Aleß** at Rudersberg on 17 August 1680.^[88] She was born 20 October 1656 at Zumhof in the parish of Steinenberg, Württemberg, daughter of Adam and Maria (Nachtrieb) Aleß (see *3833*. *Aleß*, 2, ii.), and was baptized the following day, with Hans Fahl of Oberschlechtbach and Eva, wife of Michael Schahl of Rudersberg, as sponsors.^[89] Anna died at Kallenberg on 26 September 1732, aged 76 years less 3 weeks. 5. **Jerg**^F **Klotz**^[126] (*Jerg*^G, *Michael*^H, *Hans*^I, *Leonhard*^{J/K}), of Kallenberg, and judge of the Weissach civil district (*Weißachischer Amtsrichter*) at the time of his death, was born as Georgius on 21 January 1684 at Kallenberg. The sponsors at his baptism were Jacob Hinterer of Rudersberg and his wife, in absentia, and Anna Margretha, wife of M. Daniel Harttman, the parish pastor. He succeeded his father as *Schultheiß*, being so named in the 1715 baptism record of his daughter

Elisabetha Magdalena.^[128] As Georg, he died at Kallenberg on 3 October 1765, aged 81 years, 8 months, and 11 days, and was buried at Rudersberg on 5 October 1765.^[129] He married **Anna Schmidt** at Rudersberg on 2 February 1712. She was the daughter of the late Hans Schmidt of Oberndorf.^[130] She was born about 1687, died at Kallenberg on 27 July 1757, aged about (*ohnge-fähr*) 70 years, and was buried two days later at Rudersberg.^[131] However, her family is not recorded in the Oberndorf village birth registers.

6. **Paul**^E **Klotz** (*Jerg*^{F-G}, *Michael*^H, *Hans*^I, *Leonhard*^{J/K}), of Birkenweissbuch in the parish of Oppelsbohm, Württemberg, was born at Kallenberg and baptized at Rudersberg on 14 May 1719. His baptism was sponsored by Hanß Jerg Laier of Lutzenberg and his wife Anna Maria. He died at Birkenweissbuch on 12 November 1787, aged 68 years, 6 months, and 3 days, and was buried two days later at Oppelsbohm. He married at Birkenweissbuch on Trinity Sunday, 21 June 1746, **Anna Barbara Wegscheider**. She was born at Birkenweissbuch on 21 January 1724, daughter of Johannes and Anna Maria (Dannenhauer) Wegscheider of Birkenweissbuch (see 1919. *Dannenhauer*, 3, i.). The sponsors at her baptism were Matthäus Aicholz and his wife Barbara. Barbara died at Birkenweissbuch on 24 April 1801, aged 77 years, 3 months and 3 days. She was buried 26 April 1801 at Oppelsbohm. The lands known as Weissbuch were under the control of Württemberg, by overlordship of the monastery of Lorch, from 1372. Birkenweissbuch was separately identified by 1524.
