1. **Albrecht**^H **Kübler**^[1] was an inhabitant of Wüstenbachhof in the parish of Rietenau in 1626, when his daughter Anna died,^[2] but had died by 1649, when his son Martin was married.^[3] This place was incorporated into the parish in 1456. The duchy of Württemberg^[4] long claimed sovereignty over Rietenau against the resistance of its inhabitants, but in 1564 the latter were forced to accede ("mußten die Einwohner . . . Württemberg huldigen"). Wüstenbachhof later was transferred to the parish and civil jurisdiction (Gemeinde) of Kirchberg an der Murr.^[5] Albrecht formerly lived at Ellenweiler in the parish of Oppenweiler. This place was longer under Württemberg's rule; in 1439, it was among the fiefs pledged by the counts, as possessions of the castle of Reichenberg.^[6] Albrecht's first wife was **Waltburga** _____, who was an inhabitant of Ellenweiler and was buried at Oppenweiler on 7 June 1610. On 16 June 1611 at Oppenweiler, he married **Anna** (_____) **Müller**, widow of **Michael Müller**, as his second wife.^[7] She lived at least through 1620. Children of Albrecht^H and Waltburga (_____) Kubler, baptized at Oppenweiler, are:

- 2. **Martin**^G **Kübler** (*Albrecht*^H),^[20] known as "alt" Martin^[21] of Erbstetten, which had been part of Württemberg since 1453,^[22] was baptized at Rietenau on 14 January 1620. The sponsor at his baptism was Martin Sanzenbacher of Rietenau.^[23] He died at Erbstetten on 12 January 1676, aged 56 years, and was buried the following day.^[24] He married **Martha Ackermann** on 6 May 1649 at Erbstetten.^[25] She was baptized at Erbstetten on 11 January 1629, daughter of Hanß and Anna (Fischer) (Klöpfer) Ackermann (see *939*, *3779*. *Ackermann*, 3, d. xii.), with sponsor Tabitha, wife of M. Georg Steinhofer.^[26] Martha died at Erbstetten on 24 December 1675, aged 47 years, and was buried 26 December.^[27]
