

3747. KUNTZ

1. **Jacob^H Kuntz**,^[1] of Sechselberg in the parish of Unterweissach (now Weissach im Tal), duchy of Württemberg,^[2] died by 1650, when named as deceased in the marriage record of his eldest daughter. His wife, **Maria** _____, is documented as the mother of all of his children except this same eldest daughter, Catharina, whose paternity is known only from her marriage record. Sechselberg had been ruled by Württemberg at least since 1528.^[3]
