1. **Martin^L Rumb**, sometimes *Rumm* or *Rhum*, was living in Murrhardt, duchy of Württemberg, at least through 1564. He is identified from the marriage records of his children. Murrhardt was ruled by Württemberg beginning in 1395, and Württemberg was a duchy from 1495 to 1806.^[1]

Known children of Martin Rumb include:

- i. BARTLE RUMB, m. Murrhardt 8 Feb. 1563 BARBARA JUNG, dau. of Lienhart Jung of Klaffenbach.^[2]
- + ii. WALPURGA^K RUMB, d. Murrhardt after 26 Aug. 1599,^[3] m. Murrhardt 1 Aug. 1564 HANS MACK, son of Melchior Mack of Murrhardt^[4] (see 7583. *Mack*, 2), inhabitant of Murrhardt, d. before 26 Jan. 1591.^[5]
