

7447. SCHOCK

1. **Michael¹ Schock** was of “Kirchenhof” in the duchy of Württemberg.^[1] He is known from the marriage records of his two daughters, and is believed to have lived through 1615, when his younger daughter was married.^[2]

Children of Michael¹ Schock include:

- + i. MAGDALENA^H SCHOCK, m. Murrhardt, Württemberg, 21 April 1607 JACOB WIELAND,^[3] bp. Murrhardt 10 Sept. 1579, son of Leonhard and Margretha (____) Wieland of Schönbronn in that parish, sp. Jacob Thiem^[4] (see 3723. *Wieland*, 2).
- ii. WANDELBAR SCHOCK, bur. Sulzbach an der Murr, Württemberg, 2 Sept. 1620,^[5] m. Mainhardt, Württemberg, 4 Dec. 1615 ALBRECHT WOLF, son of Hannß Wolf of Erlach in the parish of Sulzbach.^[6]
