

15297. SCHUCH

1. **Hans¹ Schuch**,^[1] of Schwaikheim in the duchy of Württemberg, died before 1603, when his daughter Anna was first married. His wife, **Dorothea** ____, was the mother of his children, but no other records of her are known. Schwaikheim was first named about 1100, and under the control of Württemberg as early as 1326.^[2] This state was a county until 1495, and then a duchy until 1806.^[3]

Leutenbach, parish of Winnenden, 8 May 1578, son of Conrad and Maria (Hofelin) Lauer, sp. Jacob Pfeill of Leutenbach,^[15] inhabitant of Leutenbach, bur. Winnenden 23 June 1615;^[16] m. (2) Winnenden 8 Sept. 1616 MARTIN BICKEL (*Bückhel*),^[17] widower, b. ca. 1551, d. Hertmannsweiler 14 Feb. 1621, aged 70y.^[18]
- iv. HANS SCHUCH, b. 22 Jan. 1588, sp. Gilg Schäffer and Anna, wife of Jörg Khöltz.^[19]
- + v. MARIA¹ SCHUCH, b. 11 June 1591, sp. Gilg Schäffer and Anna, wife of Jerg Khöltz,^[20] d. Winnenden 14 May 1655, aged 75y [*sic*],^[21] m. (1) Winnenden 15 April 1610 JACOB KAMM, son of the late Hans
