7627. SIGLIN

1. **Hans**^I **Siglin**,^[1] "senior," of Ödernhardt in the parish of Oppelsbohm, duchy of Württemberg, died between 10 July 1631, when his daughter Catharina was married, and 1637. His only recorded wife was **Margretha** _____, called Gretha prior to 1637, but she is not recorded as the mother of all of his children. On the third Sunday after Epiphany [22 January] 1637 at Ödernhardt, Margretha was married to **Samuel Dill**.^[2] Ödernhardt is first named in 1428. The area belonged to the civil district (*Amt*) of Winnenden under the county of Württemberg from 1326,^[3] which became a duchy from 1495 to 1806.^[4]

A child of Hans^I Siglin, possibly not by Margretha, is:
