

## 233. STARCK

The southern German state of Württemberg was ruled by counts through 1495, and then as a duchy from 1495 to 1806, when it became a kingdom. At this point it consolidated its territory. Parts of the kingdom had been under the authority of other rulers, but not the places of major interest here. In 1918, both the empire and the monarchy of Württemberg were abolished.<sup>[1]</sup> *Oberweissach* was named as early as 910. In 1245, *Unterweissach*, along with a mill in Oberweissach and other possessions, were confirmed by the pope to the monastery at Backnang, which by 1363 had also acquired the feudal fief of Oberweissach.<sup>[2]</sup> By 1528 it also held the tithes of fruit and wine from *Lippoldswweiler*.<sup>[3]</sup> These holdings evidently were all administered by Württemberg at least from the time of their association with the monastery. The castle at Reichenberg passed from Baden to Württemberg in 1325. Among its possessions was *Zell*, which along with Oberweissach and Unterweissach was among the fiefs pledged by the counts of Württemberg to two of their vassals in 1439.<sup>[4]</sup>

1. **Claus<sup>G/H</sup> Starck**, of Oberweissach, parish of Unterweissach (now Weissach im Tal) in the duchy of Württemberg, was buried at Unterweissach on 6 October 1654.<sup>[5]</sup> He and his first wife, **Appolonia** \_\_\_\_\_, were inhabitants of Oberweissach through 1627, and then Lippoldswweiler in the same parish. By 1642, Appolonia appears to have died, and Claus married secondly, **Anna** \_\_\_\_\_. They remained in Lippoldswweiler at least through 1643, and then moved back to Oberweissach by the time Anna died. She was buried at Unterweissach on 3 August 1649.<sup>[6]</sup> Claus married thirdly **Madlena** (\_\_\_\_) **Spindel**, widow of Michel Spindel of Meinheim in the lordship of Hohenlohe (*Hohenloische Herrschaft*), at Unterweissach on 27 August 1650.<sup>[7]</sup> As Magdalena, widow of Nicolai Starck of "Oberweißig," she was remarried at Oppenweiler, Württemberg, on 4 March 1655, to Veit Vogelmann, widower, of Zell in that parish.<sup>[8]</sup> She was born about 1601, and died as a resident of Zell on 3 August 1683, in her 83rd year.<sup>[9]</sup>

2. **Ulrich<sup>F</sup> Starck**<sup>[19]</sup> (*Claus<sup>G/H</sup>*), of Oberweissach, parish of Unterweissach, was baptized at Unterweissach on 13 December 1629, with Ulrich Spitzer of Oberweissach as sponsor. His parents were then living at Lippoldsweiler.<sup>[20]</sup> As old Ulrich Starck, he died on 12 June 1712, aged 88 years less 14 days [*sic*], and was buried at Unterweissach.<sup>[21]</sup> He married **Barbara Heinrich**, daughter of the late Hans Heinrich of Däffern (see 1865. *Heinrich*, 1, iii.), on 14 October 1650 at Unterweissach.<sup>[22]</sup> It is difficult to determine her birth date or position in the Heinrich family based on the the birth dates of her children.

3. **Niclaus<sup>G</sup> Starck<sup>[36]</sup>** (*Claus<sup>G/H</sup>*), of Oberweissach, was baptized at Unterweissach on 10 June 1642. The sponsor at his baptism was Peter Klein, of Unterbrüden.<sup>[37]</sup> He was buried at Unterweissach on 27 April 1703, aged 60 years.<sup>[38]</sup> Niclaus married **Anna Klein** at Unterweissach on 31 May 1681. She was the daughter of Hans Klein of Heiningen in the parish of Backnang, Württemberg.<sup>[39]</sup> She was born about 1652, and died an inhabitant of Oberweissach on 25 April 1704, aged 52 years.<sup>[40]</sup>

The only known child of Niclaus<sup>G</sup> and Anna (Klein) Starck is:

4. **Johann Ulrich<sup>E</sup> Starck<sup>[46]</sup>** (*Ulrich<sup>F</sup>, Claus<sup>G/H</sup>*), of Oberweissach, usually called Ulrich and distinguished as young Ulrich until his father died in 1712, was born by calculation on 28 July 1661. He was baptized at Unterweissach on 29 July 1661, with Sebastian Kleinknecht of Wattenweiler, judge of Ebersberg (*Ebersbergischer Richter*), as sponsor.<sup>[47]</sup> He died on 15 July 1736, aged 75 years less 13 days, and was buried at Unterweissach on 17 July 1736.<sup>[48]</sup> He was married to **Anna Maria** \_\_\_\_ by 1685.<sup>[49]</sup> She was born by calculation about early February 1667. When she died as an inhabitant of Oberweissach on 29 November 1728, aged 61 years, 9 months, and 3 weeks, she

was called the wife of Ulrich Starckh, *Schultheiß*. She was buried at Unterweissach on 2 December 1728.<sup>[50]</sup>

5. **Hans Jacob<sup>D</sup> Starck<sup>[81]</sup>** (*Johann Ulrich<sup>E</sup>, Ulrich<sup>F</sup>, Claus<sup>G/H</sup>*) of Oberweissach, farmer, was baptized at Unterweissach on 6 June 1707, as Jacobus, son of young Ulrich Starck of Oberweissach. The sponsors at Jacob's baptism included Jerg Lair of Steinbach and his wife, and the wife of Erich Ackermann of Unterbrüden.<sup>[82]</sup> Jacob died on 27 January 1784 as an inhabitant of Oberweissach, aged 76 years, 6 months, and 3 weeks, and was buried at Unterweissach two days later.<sup>[83]</sup> He married **Anna Barbara Jung** at Unterweissach on 8 February 1729.<sup>[84]</sup> She was baptized at Unterweissach on 13 October 1707, daughter of Hans Melchior and Anna (Kugler) Jung of Hohnweiler (see 467. *Jung*, 3, i.), with sponsors Hanß Kibler and his wife Barbara.<sup>[85]</sup> She died 18 December 1770, as wife of Jacob Starck of Oberweissach, aged 63 years, and was buried at Unterweissach on 21 December 1770.<sup>[86]</sup>
