## **477. THIERINGER**

1. \_\_\_\_\_<sup>I</sup> **Thieringer** is presumed to be the father of Burkhardt and Ulrich. In a 1663 birth record in the parish of Steinenberg, duchy of Württemberg, the sponsors of a child of Hans and Catharina Traub were Hannß Ulrich<sup>H</sup> Thieringer and his *Beschweig*, Anna Magdalena Thieringerin.<sup>[1]</sup> The only known adult inhabitant of Steinenberg at the time with this name is Burkhardt's wife. In modern German, the word for a mother-in-law is *Schwiegermutter*, but we would expect Ulrich's mother-in-law to bear a different surname. *Schwägerin* is the word for a sister-in-law, and *be*- is used as a prefix for both nouns (as in *Bericht*, a report) and adjectives (such as *bekommen*, gotten), in conjunction with passive verbs. *Beschweig* might mean "someone related by marriage," and such a relationship would depend on Ulrich also being Burkhardt's brother.

Burkhardt and Ulrich<sup>H</sup>'s father perhaps was another Hans Ulrich Thieringer, *Amtsverweser* (a minor civil officer) of Steinenberg.<sup>[2]</sup> As respected members of the community, he and his wife, Anna, often sponsored baptisms in the parish church. These records date Ulrich's death between 23 July and 5 October 1644. In addition, the entry of 7 May 1644 suggests that he had a daughter named Anna, who was the wife of Hans Betz. As Ulrich's widow, Anna was married secondly at Winnenden, Württemberg, on 22 July 1645, to Georg Pfleiderer, *Schultheiß* (appointed village mayor) of Hertmannsweiler in that parish.<sup>[18]</sup> Anna died at Hertmannsweiler on 23 March 1649, aged 60 years.<sup>[19]</sup>

Steinenberg was first named in 1234 as the property of the monastery of Adelberg. Parts of the fee sometimes passed out of the monastery's ownership, but were restored to that house by 1524, which maintained a monastic office in the village. [20] The county of Württemberg assumed the permanent overlordship of the monastery's lands in 1372. [21] Württemberg was a duchy from 1495 to 1806. [22]

2. **Hans Ulrich**<sup>H</sup> **Thieringer**<sup>[31]</sup> (?*Hans Ulrich*<sup>I</sup>), of Steinenberg, was born about 1619, and died 14 April 1683 at Steinenberg, aged 64 years. He was buried there on 17 April 1683. His death record also says that he had been married for 39 years and 6 weeks, thus since about early March 1644. His wife, **Anna** \_\_\_\_\_, is recorded as the mother of all of his children. She was born about 1621, and was buried at Steinenberg on 23 January 1687, aged 65 years. - 3. Hans Ulrich<sup>G</sup> Thieringer (Hans Ulrich<sup>H</sup>, ?Hans Ulrich<sup>I</sup>) was baptized 18 February 1655 at Steinenberg. His sponsors were Johann Georg Weishardt, the pastor, his wife Magdalena, and Maria, wife of Jerg Maÿer, smith.<sup>[66]</sup> Ulrich was buried at Steinenberg on 3 June 1694, aged 39 years, 14 weeks, and 5 days.<sup>[67]</sup> He was called "jung" in the baptisms of his first three children, but by 1682 that descriptor seems to have shifted to his cousin, the son of Burkhardt (1, ii.).<sup>[68]</sup> Thereafter these two men were distinguished by occupation; Ulrich<sup>G</sup> was a Forstknecht (woodsman) whose wife was Sara, and his cousin was a Beck (baker) whose wife was Anna.<sup>[69]</sup> Ulrich<sup>G</sup> married Anna Sara Schwartz at Steinenberg on 25 July 1677.<sup>[70]</sup> She was usually called Sara, and was born 25 March 1652 at Steinenberg, daughter of the Forstknecht Hans and Anna (\_\_\_\_) Schwartz (see 3817. Schwartz, 1 v.). The sponsors at her baptism were Anna Catharina Keppelmann, wife of the pastor, and Margaretha, widow of Lienerth Negelin.<sup>[71]</sup> Sara was buried at Steinenberg on 28 July 1729, aged 77 years and 4 months, and the longtime widow of Jacob Schal.<sup>[72]</sup> She had married secondly, at Steinenberg on 6 November 1694, Hans Jacob Schaal, citi-

- 4. **Johann Jacob**<sup>F</sup> **Thieringer** (*Hans Ulrich*<sup>G-H</sup>, ?*Hans Ulrich*<sup>I</sup>) of Steinenberg and Buhlbronn, was born at Steinenberg on 5 June 1678. The sponsors at baptism were Jacob Heinrich, and Barbara, wife of Jacob Schaal. [86] He was buried at Oppelsbohm, Württemberg, on 6 January 1759, aged 80 years and 2 months less 2 days. [87] He first married **Anna Maria Schwartz** at Steinenberg on 15 July 1704. [88] She was born at Steinenberg on 20 September 1684, the daughter of Hans Schwartz, called "Demas," and his wife Maria (Jetzlin). Sponsors at her baptism were Jacob Schaal, *Schultheiß*, and Catharina, wife of Jost Keiser. [89] She died at Steinenberg on 28 October 1704, fifteen weeks after their marriage, aged 20 years and 5 weeks. [90] They had no children. As a widower of Steinenberg, he married **Maria Jeitter** at Buhlbronn, parish of Oppelsbohm, on 23 June 1705. [91] Maria was born at Buhlbronn on 4 September 1682, daughter of Jerg and Maria (Fritz) Jeitter (see 1909, 7655. *Jeitter*, 3, ii.). The sponsors at her baptism were Johann Jacob Palm

and his wife Anna Barbara, of Schorndorf. [92] Maria was buried at Oppelsbohm on 12 February 1756, aged 73 years, 5 months, and 5 days. [93] Buhlbronn was ruled by Württemberg from 1411. [94]

bohm, daughter of Georg and Catharina (Ulmer) (Entemann) Ricker (see 1911. Ulmer, 4, v.). The date of the entry is unclear, but it is recorded next after 26 April 1724. Sponsors at her baptism were Matthes Jeitter and Margaretha, widow of another Matthes Jeitter. As Maria, wife of Leonhardt Wahl, she reportedly was born 27 April 1724, died at Buhlbronn on 8 December 1790, and was buried at Oppelsbohm on 10 December 1790, aged 66 years, 7 months, and 11 days. She married second, at Buhlbronn on 7 August 1759, **Georg Leonhard Wahl**. He was born at Unterschlechtbach in the parish of Oppelsbohm on 6 May 1733, son of Adam and Margaretha (Fetzer) Wahl. His baptism was sponsored by Georg Gauller and his wife Barbara of the same village. Georg Leonhard died at Buhlbronn 31 May 1799, aged 66 years and 25 days, and was buried 2 June 1799.
