

3813. WILHELM

1. **Balthaß^I Wilhelm**, of Amt Mannheim, Pfalz, died before 1640. He is known from his son's marriage record.

2. **Balthaß^H Wilhelm^[1]** (*Balthaß^I*), of Ödernhardt, was born about 1614. He died at Ödernhardt on 11 November 1677, aged about 63 years.^[2] He married **Anna Siglin** on 11 April 1640 at Ödernhardt.^[3] She was born at Ödernhardt on 17 October 1613, daughter of Hans and Margretha (____) Siglin of that place. The sponsor at her baptism was Agnes, wife of M. Thomas Rommel^[4] (see 7627. *Siglin*, 1, ii). Anna's death date is not known, but she is recorded as the mother of all of Balthaß's children. Ödernhardt is first named in 1428. The area belonged to the civil district (*Amt*) of Winnenden under the county of Württemberg from 1326,^[5] which became a duchy from 1495 to 1806.^[6]

Geradstetten 8 Feb. 1670 MICHAEL WALTER,^[16] b. 10 March 1641, son of Michael and Anna (Meinle) Walter of Aurbach,^[17] d. Geradstetten 7, bur. 9 Feb. 1702, aged 61y less 1m.^[18]

- + iii. ANNA^G WILHELM,^[19] b. 29 June 1644, sp. Maria, wife of Hanß Siglin, *Schultheiß*,^[20] inhabitant of Buhlbronn, parish of Oppelsbohm, d. after 1685,^[21] m. Ödernhardt 26 Feb. 1677 HANS WALTER,^[22] b. Buhlbronn 14 Nov. 1650, son of Jacob and Anna (____) Walter (see 953. *Walter*, 2), sp. Georg Kurtz,^[23] inhabitant of Buhlbronn, d. between 30 April 1708 and 20 Aug. 1709.^[24]
- iv. BALTHAS WILHELM,^[25] twin, b. 20 Nov. 1647, sp. Maria, wife of Michael Ehmann of Miedelsbach,^[26] lieutenant of Felix Diboldt's company of musketeers, d. Horrheim, Württemberg, 19 Nov. 1691,^[27] m. Ödernhardt 2 Feb. 1675 MAGDALENA ADE, dau. of Joß Ade of Heiningen,^[28] who survived him, and m. (2) Rettersberg, parish of Oppelsbohm, 21 June 1703 Hans Georg Sold, widower.^[29]
- v. CATHARINA WILHELM, twin, b. 20 Nov. 1647, sp. Maria, wife of Michael Ehmann of Miedelsbach,^[30] d. Ödernhardt 30 Oct. 1648.^[31]
