## **3813. WILHELM**

- 1. **Balthaß¹ Wilhelm**, of Amt Mannheim, Pfalz, died before 1640. He is known from his son's marriage record.
- 2. **Balthaß**<sup>H</sup> **Wilhelm**<sup>[1]</sup> (*Balthaß*<sup>1</sup>), of Ödernhardt, was born about 1614. He died at Ödernhardt on 11 November 1677, aged about 63 years.<sup>[2]</sup> He married **Anna Siglin** on 11 April 1640 at Ödernhardt.<sup>[3]</sup> She was born at Ödernhardt on 17 October 1613, daughter of Hans and Margretha (\_\_\_\_) Siglin of that place. The sponsor at her baptism was Agnes, wife of M. Thomas Rommel<sup>[4]</sup> (see 7627. *Siglin*, 1, ii). Anna's death date is not known, but she is recorded as the mother of all of Balthaß's children. Ödernhardt is first named in 1428. The area belonged to the civil district (*Amt*) of Winnenden under the county of Württemberg from 1326,<sup>[5]</sup> which became a duchy from 1495 to 1806.<sup>[6]</sup>
