

1871. WURST

1. **Michael¹ Wurst** was a resident of Wolfenbrück 1574 to 1576, and then moved to Hoffeld, where he lived from 1579 to 1584. Both were filials of the parish of Murrhardt, which was principally administered, from 1395 on, by the duchy of Württemberg. Hoffeld seems not to appear in medieval documents and perhaps had assumed its name only recently when the parish register began in 1559. It seems to have been ruled solely by Württemberg.^[1] Wolfenbrück, by contrast, was a loosely organized settlement that, from 1441 to 1690, was ruled partly by Württemberg and partly by the lordship of Limpurg-Gaildorf.^[2] Michael is named as an inhabitant of Hoffeld at the marriage of his daughter Elsa, in 1603, and as deceased at the marriage of his son Jerg, in 1611. All of Michael's known children were born to the same wife, **Maria _____**.

- ii. ELISABETHA WURST, bp. [–] Dec. 1576, sp. Elisabetha, wife of Hanns Schellin of Murrhardt,^[9] inhabitant of Wolfenbrück, d. after 11 Nov. 1617,^[10] as Elsa m. [–] Aug. 1603 MELCHIOR KLENCK,^[11] bp. Murrhardt 24 Dec. 1576, son of Bartlin and Margaretha (____) Klenck of Steinberg, sp. Melchior Schwartz of Murrhardt.^[12] He was perhaps the inhabitant of Mettelbach who was bur. Murrhardt 3 Sept. 1626.^[13]
- iii. THOMAS WURST, bp. 23 Nov. 1579, sp. Hans Schollin of Murrhardt.^[14]

v. JOHANNES WURST, bp. 23 Oct. 1584, sp. Hanß Müller the younger of Murrhardt.^[15]

2. **Jerg^H Wurst** (*Michael^I*) was baptized at Murrhardt on 20 January 1582, sponsored by Jerg Laub of Murrhardt.^[16] From the date of his marriage on, he lived at Hinterwestermurr, parish of Murrhardt, which had been ruled by the dukes of Württemberg since 1504.^[17] On 29 January 1611 at Murrhardt, he married **Walburga (Kurtz) Sameth**—incorrectly named as *Catharina* in this record, and not in records relating to her previous marriage or her children with Jerg.^[18] She was the daughter of Isaac Kurtz of Trailhof, parish of Oberbrüden, Württemberg, deceased (see 7451, 7485. *Kurtz*, 1, ii.), and previously the widow of Hans^H Sameth of Hinterwestermurr^[19] (see 3725. *Sameth*, 2). Jerg and Walburga were both living through 1619. They may have died before 1626, when burials are first recorded in Murrhardt.

3. **Bartholomäus^G Wurst** (*Georg^H, Michael^I*), of Hinterwestermurr, was baptized at Murrhardt on 23 March 1615, and was sponsored by Jacob Hackhel of Murrhardt.^[22] He was buried at Murrhardt on 13 November 1670, aged 55 years and 8 months.^[23] Neither of his two marriages is recorded in the parish register; in Murrhardt, most sacraments were not recorded from 1639 through 1643. His first wife was **Anna Maria** ____, the mother of his two eldest sons. Bartholomäus's second wife was **Christina** ____, the mother of his younger children. She was born about 1617. As a resident of Hinterwestermurr, she was buried at Murrhardt on 25 April 1687, aged 70 years.^[24] Not all of her children's baptisms appear in the church register.
