

951. ZELTWANGER

The southern German state of Württemberg was ruled by counts through 1495, and then as a duchy from 1495 to 1806, when it became a kingdom. At this point it consolidated its territory. Parts of the kingdom had been under the authority of other rulers, but not the places of major interest here. In 1918, both the empire and the monarchy of Württemberg were abolished.^[1] *Oppenweiler* (no. 1) seems originally to have been a Baden fief, but came under the feudal overlordship of Württemberg by the early 14th century. Its local ruling family, the Sturmfeders, only fully submitted to the government of Württemberg in 1806.^[2] *Unterweissach* (nos. 2-3) and other possessions were confirmed by the pope to the monastery at Backnang in 1245.^[3] This holding evidently was administered by Württemberg at least from the time of its association with the monastery. The monastery also had rights in *Heiningen* (no. 4) as early as 1134, though at the time it was ruled by the count of Löwenstein. However, in 1439 Heiningen was among the fiefs pledged by the counts of Württemberg to two of their vassals.^[4]

1. **Paul¹ Zeltwanger**^[5] of the village and parish of Oppenweiler, duchy of Württemberg,^[6] was a native of the Austrian Empire, according to the record of his marriage. He was buried at Oppenweiler on 1 April 1660.^[7] His marriage to **Waltburga Schönlin** was confirmed (*ihr ehe bestätigen lassen*) at Oppenweiler on 27 January 1652. The record does not identify their fathers.^[8] After Paul died, Waltburga was married at Unterweissach, Württemberg, on 26 September 1665, **Johann Neubauer**, widower of Heutensbach in that parish.^[9]

- iii. BARBARA ZELTWANGER, bp. 1 Nov. 1656, sp. Maria, wife of Veyht Ohlgeier,^[11] bur. Oppenweiler 20 Sept. 1657.^[12]

2. **Hans Jerg^H Zeltwanger^[13]** (*Paul!*), of Unterweissach, was baptized at Oppenweiler on 8 May 1653, and sponsored by H. Georg Gabriel of Oppenweiler.^[14] He died sometime between 11 February 1710, when his daughter Anna Maria married,^[15] and 29 June 1712, when his son Sebastian died.^[16] He married at Unterweissach on 21 September 1675 **Barbara Sanzenbacher**.^[17] She was born about 1659, and was buried at Unterweissach on 2 April 1709. Her age was given as 51 years and 13 days,^[18] but this would calculate a birth date only three months after her brother Martin. Barbara and Martin were children of Hans and Maria (Ulrich) Sanzenbacher^[19] (see 117, 7609. *Sanzenbacher*, 2, iii.).

3. **Hans Jerg^G Zeltwanger^[40]** (*Hans Jerg^H, Paul^I*), of Unterweissach, known as “jung” to distinguish him from his father, was baptized at Unterweissach on 12 February 1680. Sponsors at his baptism were Jerg Betzelberger, miller of Unterweissach, and his wife Anna Barbara.^[41] He died at Unterweissach on 17 August 1764, aged 84 years, and was buried there on 19 August 1764.^[42] He first married **Anna Barbara Schuster** at Unterweissach on 14 February 1702.^[43] She was baptized at Obergröningen, then in the county of Limpurg but later in Württemberg, on 6 April 1684, daughter of Jacob and Barbara (Weller) Schuster (see 7611. *Schuster*, 2, ii.) of that parish. The sponsors at her baptism were the pastor’s wife, Maria Seyferlin, and Barbara, wife of Hans Schuster of Obergröningen.^[44] She was buried at Unterweissach on 16 February 1743, aged 72 years and 4 months [*sic*].^[45] Jerg was married secondly at Unterweissach on 26 February 1748 to **Maria Doderer**.^[46] She was baptized at Unterweissach on 19 January 1684, daughter of Johann Michael and Anna Maria (Seitter) Doderer of Unterweissach, with sponsors Jerg Krauter and wife Maria of Unterweissach.^[47] Maria was buried at Unterweissach on 21 October 1748, aged 64

4. **Philipp Heinrich^F Zeltwanger^[61]** (*Hans Jerg^{G-H}, Paul^I*), of Heiningen, parish of Backnang, Württemberg, usually known as Heinrich, was born, by calculation, and baptized 6 February 1705 at Unterweissach. The sponsor at his baptism was H. Philipp Sadler, lieutenant.^[62] He died 1 January 1771 as an inhabitant of Heiningen, aged 66 years, 11 months and 4 days.^[63] He married, at Backnang on 7 May 1726, **Anna Magdalena Beißwanger**, usually called Magdalena.^[64] She was baptized at Backnang on 8 March 1708, the daughter of Jacob and Anna Maria (Stigelmaier) Beißwanger of Heiningen, with sponsors Balthas Rumpf, *Schultheiß* of Heiningen, and his wife

Margaretha.^[65] She died as an inhabitant of Heiningen on 3 March 1775, aged 67 years and 3 weeks.^[66]
