

7433. KNÖDLER

1. **Hans¹ Knödler**, of Bruckhof, parish of Welzheim, was apparently living at least through 1604, when his daughter Barbara was married. This place, alternately known as Heinlenshof, belonged to the county of Limpurg until the kingdom of Württemberg absorbed its territory in 1806.^[1] Hans had two known daughters:

- i. ANNA KNÖDLER,^[2] m. Welzheim 20 Feb. 1598 HANS WAHLENMAIER, son of the late Jerg Wahlenmaier of Wahlenheim, also then in the county of Limpurg;^[3] inhabitants of Wahlenheim; last known child b. 28 July 1611.^[4]
- + ii. BARBARA^H KNÖDLER,^[5] perhaps d. as Anna, Wahlenheim 5 April 1632,^[6] m. Welzheim 3 Sept. 1604 HANS WAHL, son of the late Balthas Wahl of Wahlenheim, inhabitant of Wahlenheim^[7] (see 929. *Wahl*, 2), d. Wahlenheim 8 April 1632.^[8]
